INCLEMENT WEATHER CLOSURE: Legacy Community Health Clinics Closed Monday

HOUSTON, TX – (July 7, 2024) To ensure the safety of patients and staff, [Legacy Community Health clinics](#) are closing on Monday, July 8 due to the tropical storm Beryl in our region.

All Telehealth appointments will continue Monday as planned.

Patients with appointments scheduled when the clinics are closed will be contacted proactively by clinic staff to reschedule their appointments.

School Based Health locations will follow the schedules of YES Prep, KIPP and Galena Park ISD schools on Tuesday.

Legacy will determine potential late openings and closures across all locations and regions for Tuesday, July 9 tomorrow. Any changes or specific clinic closures due to further weather issues will be announced on Monday evening.
